The Danger in Discipleship

Mark 10:32-34 / March 29, 2020

Big Question: What helps a disciple when life gets hard?

- Understand that Jesus will sometimes lead you into a <u>dangerous</u> situation (v32)
 - For background, see John 7-10
 - They were <u>amazed</u>
 - They were <u>afraid</u>
 - The <u>followed</u> Him anyway
- Take comfort that Jesus spells out who will <u>take action</u> against Him (v33)
 - Chief priests those in <u>authority</u>
 - Scribes those who are <u>educated</u>
 - Gentiles those who are <u>unbelievers</u>
- Draw strength from the fact that Jesus gives us a picture of <u>actions</u> to come (v34)
 - Mock <u>verbal insult</u>
 - Spit physical insult
 - Flog physical <u>harm</u>
 - Kill physical <u>death</u>
 - \circ Rise after three days <u>hope</u>

SUMMARY:

Even in the middle of a dangerous situation, Jesus helps His disciples by telling them the <u>difficult truth</u> about what's to come followed by <u>hope</u>.

APPLICATION:

- Are you willing to <u>follow</u> Jesus into <u>danger</u>?
- Are you willing to embrace <u>suffering</u> to follow Jesus?
- Where is Jesus trying to <u>lead</u> you that you are <u>resisting</u> to go?
