### Application/Reflection:

- 1. Plan a family dinner & conversation to assess everyone's commitments and responsibilities. Evaluate how your family schedule reflects those priorities. Determine where your commitment to God is represented in the family schedule/commitments/responsibilities and whether or not He is clearly #1 in your family.
- 2. Plan a family game night & conversation to talk honestly about what is prized most in the family. Some questions you could ask:
  - a. Do we celebrate achievement or character?
  - b. Do we invest more in temporary or eternal things?
  - c. Do we measure success by efficiency or effectiveness?
- 3. Plan a family vacation or weekend get-a-way solely for the purpose of spiritual growth and strengthening relationships with each other and the Lord. This is not a program full of activities. The goal is to slow down and get free of distraction and commotion. Design the trip around the following:
  - a. Daily times for both individual and family devotions (Scripture, prayer, music, etc.).
  - Restrict the use of electronic devices to actual need/emergency use only. This should apply to parents as well as children. Establish "tech free" zones and times.
  - c. Based on the results of #1 and #2, discuss 1) what items need to be removed from the list of family commitments, 2) what family routines or practices need to be revised so that it better implements biblical principles (God's value system), and 3) what can be added to demonstrate the family's commitment to God as their top priority (consider your investment in His church).
